If you are a new applicant, made any changes to your personal information, or are adding/changing to a new vessel, please mail the entire application package to:

- (800, 801, 805, 806) For the purchase of a Head Boat or Charter Boat License, you must provide a copy of the current vessel registration or documentation for the boat you wish to licenses. To license multiple vessels, list all the vessel ID numbers on the lines provided on the front of the form. Each license must be purchased separately.
- (810, 813, 811, 814) For the purchase of a Class A or B Fishing Guide License, you must provide a copy of your current USCG Captain's License. Please list a primary vessel ID number on the line provided on the front of the form. Please note that the Class A Fishing Guide License is limited entry and only qualifying individuals may purchase this license. Remember, a MD Reciprocity Permit is required to use a Class A in MD waters.
- (812) For the issuance of the Fishing Guide Reciprocity Permit, you must provide a copy of your current USCG Captain's License AND your current Maryland Fishing Guide License (FGR, FGN, TFL). You must also provide a copy of your primary vessel registration or documentation.
- (473) This permit requires mandatory reporting on forms provided by the Commission or using the Virginia Saltwater Fishermen's Journal. It is the responsibility of the operator or captain of the vessel to report for the entire vessel. You will not be able to renew your cobia permit in 2020 unless you submitted your 2019 reports. These reports were due to VMRC on October 21, 2019.

Don't forget the fishing guide license discount when purchased in combination with a charter boat license Example: To calculate the purchase of one resident 6-pack charter license and a resident Class B Fishing Guide \$190 + \$100 = \$290 with the owner/fishing guide discount the total cost is \$190 for both licenses.
