DESCRIPTIVE TITLE OF PROJECT: Sunshine Program Fishing Children's Day

PROJECT SUMMARY:

This year's project is an expanded version of the annual Sunshine Program Fishing event. Each year, this program becomes larger and more established in the community. The Salvation Army now includes every chapter in the Tidewater area in our event. For the past 4 years, the Sunshine Program has taken over 120 children on 5 head boat trips into the Chesapeake Bay and two pier trips. This year, we are hoping to expand once again by including a fishing competition between the four chapters of the Salvation Army during the boat trips and pier events. THE Portsmouth Sheriff's and the Community outreach program of the Portsmouth Redelopment and Housing program have joined us with the need for services to 500+ children in their programs. Supporting the continual evolution of an established charitable fishing program, such as the Sunshine Program, increases the communities' awareness, knowledge and concern about ecology.

1. Introduction of children to the fishing community.
2. Promotion of positive recreational activities for "at risk" children and adolescence.
3. Aiding children in understanding the Chesapeake Bay eco-system.
4. Encouraging mentoring contact between fishing adults and children
